Points from Sunday's Message

- 1. One day, Jesus will make all things new.
- 2. One day, Jesus will rule and reign forever and ever.
- **3.** One day, God will restore right order and undo the effects of the curse and stain of sin.
- **4.** One day—maybe sooner than we expect—Jesus will come again.

Key Verse:

Then He who sat on the throne said, "Behold, I make all things new." And He said to me, "Write, for these words are true and faithful."

- Revelation 21:5

Discussion Questions:

- 1. How has your understanding of 'heaven' or the 'Kingdom of God' changed after hearing Sunday's message?
- 2. What cultural ideas or images about heaven do you think influence Christians the most today?
- 3. What excites or encourages you the most about the idea of a renewed creation?
- 4. In what areas of your life do you need to 'wake up' and live with more eternal perspective, as Paul says in Romans 13?
- 5. How can you encourage others to live with hope and purpose in light of the promise, 'Behold, I make all things new'?

Use these blended questions for deeper personal reflection, prayer, or small group discussion.
