Points from Sunday's Message

1. The Nicene Creed is a simple statement about God upon which Christians are agreed.
2. Belief in God as creator is not anti-science, it is a worldview that explains why science works.
3. The rationality God designed into creation became the very tool humans used to reason God away.
4. Jesus immanatizes the transcendent.
5. As Jesus brings transcendence near, He brings meaning, purpose, and hope to everything.

Key Verse:

"All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made."

Discussion Questions:

1. What stood out to you the most about the history and purpose of the Nicene Creed?
2. Why is it significant that Christians of all traditions can affirm the words of the Nicene Creed, despite other differences?
3. How did the Enlightenment change the way people thought about God, science, and reason?
4. The message said, "Jesus immanatizes the transcendent." What does that mean in your own words, and why is it important?
5. How does knowing Jesus as Creator and Sustainer bring meaning and hope to your everyday life?

6. Is there an area in your life where you sense Jesus is calling you to trust Him more fully? How can this group encourage or pray for you in that?

Use these blended questions for deeper personal reflection, prayer, or small group discussion.
